Description: Though small, the size of "Young Girl at Window" is what contributes to its overall closeness and intimacy. The eye is quickly drawn into the painting by the busy foliage and then slowly travels upward to the delicate face of the young girl.

The strong colors of the composition are contrasted by the red bow in her hair and her full lips against the muted colors of the background. Her handkerchief is a shocking white that seems to wave the viewer in. While possessing an intimate feeling, the young girl's distant expression also conveys a wistful and contemplative mood. The diminutive size of "Young Girl at Window" beckons the viewer to look closely at this intimate painting.
