

Description: In "New York Library, Fifth Avenue" the artist captures a fleeting moment during a cold, winter day. The painting has the same soft, romantic sensibility as the work of Childe Hassam (1859-1935), whom the artist greatly admired. Wiggins also painted many similar subjects which are reminiscent of Hassam's famous Flag Paintings. Although the painting is nearly devoid of human activity, the artist manages to capture the chaos of city life through the movement of snow alone.
