Description: Frankie Ippolito (1934-2002), the subject of these photographs, was a New York-based lightweight fighter who compiled a lifetime record of 22 wins, 10 losses, and 2 ties during his seven year boxing career between 1952 and 1959. In an extensive series of photographs, Jacques Lowe strove to capture intimate moments throughout the full range of Ippolito's life as father, husband, teacher, and fighter. Born in Cologne, Germany, Lowe was a photojournalist who created portraits of leading political, business, and entertainment personalities. He is best known for his photographs of John F. Kennedy, taken while serving as his official campaign photographer.
